3. RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES

Nirmala College of Pharmacy, Muvattupuzha has established Research and faculty development cell with the intention to uphold the research activities and the upliftment of overall scientific approach among the BPharm, Pharm D, MPharm students and staff of the college.

3.1 Activities of R and D cell during the academic year 2019-2020

1. <u>Student research activities</u>

Research and Development Cell will evaluate the projects in three steps: Title Presentation of proposed project, Mid-thesis evaluation, Final Presentation.

For the title presentation student has to submit the proposed protocol along with a set of forms suggested by R & D cell.

BPharm Project: As per the instructions from KUHS final year BPharm student has to do a project work and present the work in front of a team of senior faculty for evaluation.

In Nirmala college of Pharmacy, 16 staff members have guided the BPharm Projects in the academic year 2019-2020. A total of 16 batches were formed with 4 members in 14 batches and 3 members in 2 batches. Students were allotted to the staff members using lot systems.

The title presentation was conducted on 12-3-2019 in the seminar hall of NCP. After the presentation, the final protocol was submitted.

Mid thesis evaluation was conducted in the month of October. The Final thesis presentation was conducted on 15/2/2020 and it was evaluated by the scientific committee of Nirmala College of Pharmacy. The Project marks are submitted to the University.

Pharm D projects: As per PCI and KUHS, Pharm D students have to undertake project in their 5th year of course in a group of 3-5 candidates and the guides should possess at least 5 years of experience.

Four staff members from the Dept. of Pharmacy Practice are eligible to guide the students. A total of 8 batches were formed with four members in five group and three members in three groups. Seven students are allotted to each staff randomly by lot system. Individual staff divided the students into 2 groups based on their preferences and the final list was circulated to students.

The title presentation was conducted on Sept 30^{th} 2019 in the seminar hall. The internal Evaluation of Pharm D projects were performed on 17/07/2020 and 18/7/2020 using google meet Platform.

M Pharm Projects: In the academic year 2019-2020, 6 MPharm Students are doing the Project as a part of fulfilment of their post-graduation.

2. <u>Pharma alert</u>

It's a good platform for students to learn new information in pharmacy and research. In this academic year, 10 batches have participated in Pharma Alert. The first Pharma alert display was done on 21/8/2019 by fourth Pharm D students. The presentation was done bimonthly. Pharma Alert topics include information regarding 25 new drugs, 1 new device and 1 safety alert.

3. <u>NDC (New Drug Cortex)</u>

It is the program initialized to support the learning of most commonly used drugs. For this purpose, 200 most commonly used drugs have been identified and allotted 30-40 drugs each to all batches of students. Students have prepared the flashcards detailing the most important points of each drugs. There is an assessment session about these drugs to check the effectiveness of the program.

4. <u>Publications (evaluation of quality and financial assistance)</u>

Financial system has been initialized to assist and encourage the publications by the staff. The articles which is published in indexed journals (Web of Science /Scopus) will be financially assisted by R and D cell. In the last academic year 8 publications and 1 seminar were received financial assistance. 5 faculties were benefited from this.

Typeset, an editing software support has been arranged in order to promote research grants proposals and quality publications

5. <u>Guest lectures</u>

- External Guest lectures: In the academic year 2019-2020 R and D cell have conducted 2 guest lectures and 2 Webinars
- The first lecture was by Dr. Jimmy Jose, Associate Professor, School Of Pharmacy, University Of Niswa, Sultanate Of Oman on 9-07-2019 on the topic "Improving medication adherence: potential approaches and career opportunities for pharmacy graduates"
- The second lecture was by Dr. Vrinda Nampoothiri on "Antibiotic Stewardship Programme: Interventions and Implications" on 29-08-2019
- The Research and Development Cell (R & D) of Nirmala College of pharmacy held an industry guest lecture-based webinar on 14th June 2020 from the Managers of Accenture and Indegene, Bangalore on topic 'Let's explore the opportunities at Clinical Industry'.
- A basic and advanced statistical software (JMAP- a SAS product) Training Program'
- By Dr. Muralidhara Anandamurthy for the Students and Faculties of Nirmala college of Pharmacy was organized by R and D cell on 11/7/2020

<u>Internal Guest lectures</u>: R and D cell decided to organize series of lectures from the R and D cell members in order to contribute in learning and enhancing the research understanding among students and faculties as well as to prepare the quality speakers among ourselves to serve the need for outside interaction in future.

• In this sequence, R and D cell conducted its first lecture- cum workshop on "Insilico studies: with hands on training on docking softwares" by Ms. Aleesha R, Asst.

professor, Dept. of Pharmacology, Nirmala College of Pharmacy. The lecture was attended by students, faculties, R and cell members of the institute on 18th January 2020 from 1.30 PM to 4.30 PM at seminar hall.

- The second talk was by Dr. Bharat Mishra, Head of Research and Development cell and Dept. of Pharmacology, Nirmala College of Pharmacy on the topic "Opportunities and publication process in Pharm D education.
- Dr.Suja Abraham, ISPOR Faculty Advisor, Nirmala College of Pharmacy gave a talk on "the need, importance and current scenario of Health economics and Outcomes Research in Indian studies".

6. <u>Research advisory board</u>

In order to provide strategic advice in terms of research we have established a Research Advisory Board. This board will provide guidance and strategic inputs on research.

7. Grants applied for various forums.

R and D had applied grants from ISPOR, DST, AICTE, KSCSTE, ICMR and CSIR.

Application has been done for grant from AICTE for two schemes (Margdarshan and STTP).

8. <u>Application and funding of projects</u>

4 pharm D projects and 2 BPharm Projects of 2019-2020 academic year have received grants from KSCSTE.

9. <u>NEW MOUs</u>

10 MOUs have been done with 10 institutions.

10. <u>Consultancy projects</u>

Consultancy works are ongoing in Nirmala College of pharmacy from the year 2016. A total of 13 consultancy work have been received till date amounting to Rs. 77,200. Most of the consultancy works were received from Botany department of Nirmala College, Muvattupuzha. These project were handled by Dr. Fels Saju. In the academic year 2018-2019, an International consultancy from University of Gondar, Ethiopia was obtained. This work was handled and completed successfully by Dr. Bharat Mishra. We are receiving consultancy queries from various institutions for medicinal plant related works.

11. New instruments purchased

In a view to enhance the research facility few new instruments have been purchased which include Psychopharmacological mazes, Semi autoanalyzer, Trinocular microscope, Plethysmometer and Digital rotarod Apparatus
