ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2022-2023

Your Excellency Mar George Madathikandathil, The Bishop, Rev. Msgr. Dr. Pious Malekandathil, Manager, Rev. Fr. Jose Pulloppillil, Administrator Nirmala College of Pharmacy, Rev. Fathers, distinguished guests, respected Principals, and respected Managingboard members, I take this opportunity to present before you a brief report of the various activities, new ventures and achievements of Nirmala College of Pharmacy during the academic year 2022-2023.

Initiation of First year programs:

Courses for the Academic year 2022-2023 commenced on December 12th 2022 with 30 students in the first year Pharm D and 95 students in the first Semester B.Pharm. Rev. Fr. Jose Pulloppillil welcomed the students and parents. Inaugural address given by Mar George Madathikandathil, Bishop of Kothamangalam diocese, Presidential Address delivered by Rev. Msgr. Dr. Pious Malekandathil, Manager, and Principal Dr. Badmanaban R. given the keynote address and the vice Principal proposed the vote of thanks.

Students Strength at present:

The total strength of students is **583**, including **412** at UG (B.Pharm) level and **171** at Pharm.D & M.Pharm courses. Out of 583 students, 97 (15%) are boys and 461(85%) are girls.

Total Staff strength at present: 66 (Both teaching and non-teaching)

Total teaching **faculty strength is 40** , out of **40 staff, 08 (20%) male staff and 32 (80%) female staff**, out of which **10 are PhD** holders(02 faculty completed in 2022-2023)and **09**are pursuing PhD' and **26** are non-teaching staff including office and library.

I. ACHIEVEMENTS

It is a pride that our institution has completed 18 years of effective and prestigious service to the pharmacy profession. College is on the path of achieving a national higher quality of education standard.

I.1.ACCREDITATION

- 1) **Existing NBA accreditation for the B.Pharm Program** has been extended till 30th June, 2025, after the revisit by an NBA team of two expert members on 15th July 2022. Chairperson and Co-Chairman appreciated the Administrator Rev. Fr. Jose Pullopillil and the principal for maintaining the higher standards and ambience of the college during their exit meeting time. The success behind the NBA accreditation is the hard work and dedication extended by the faculty members throughout the process and the sincere efforts taken to conduct various programs and events.
- 2) Another **International Accreditation Organization (IAO)** from the USA and the **International Organization for Standardization (ISO-9001:2015 Universal Certification)** from the UK in the year 2021 has extended their validity till 2024.
- 3) **A surprise inspection was conducted by the Kerala University of Health Sciences**, on 18th April 2023 for the extension of affiliation for the existing courses for the academic year 2023-2024, waiting for the approval order. We have submitted the Standard Inspection Proforma with all the essential details of the college in the month of February 2023 to the PCI and we got the approval from PCI and extended it till 2023-2024 for all courses we are running.

I.2.INSTITUTIONAL ACHIEVEMENTS

- 1) **Nirmala College of Pharmacy has established an Institutional Innovation Cell (IIC)** as per the norms of 'MoE's Innovation Cell (MIC)', Govt. of India to foster the culture of Innovation amongst all Higher Education Institutions (HEIs). IIC helps the students and the institute to get involved in innovative activities and gain knowledge. In the 2022-2023

academic year we have conducted 13 activities in association with IEDC under the theme Innovation, Start-up, IPR and Entrepreneurship. We got a 3 star rating from IIC among the Pharmacy colleges in India.

- 2) **Innovation & Entrepreneurship development Centre (IEDC)**, an initiative of Kerala Start-up mission, was established in the year 2022 with the objective of developing an entrepreneurship culture among students. To provide entrepreneurship awareness and orientation, IEDC conducted 12 events which include workshops, orientation programs, and Experience sharing's for various batches of students. **The Centre has been awarded as the 'Top Performing IEDC' in the Innovation Premiere League conducted by Kerala Startup Mission and also bagged 4.5 Lakhs of funding in various categories** as follows :

- 3) Department of Science and Industrial Research (**DSIR**) under the department of Scientific and Industrial Research Organization (SIRO) certification has been initiated and a Contract Agreement has been signed with Scinnovation Consultants Private Limited, Mumbai on 24th September 2021 for submission and getting certification. Application has been submitted on 19th April 2023 Application No. The SIRO/2023/00041 application is under process.
- 4) The Pharmacovigilance Program of India (**PVPI**) established an adverse drug reaction monitoring centre in Nirmala medical center with the joint effort of Nirmala College of Pharmacy during 2021, to promote spontaneous reports of ADR in order to ensure patient safety. 43 ADR reports were submitted to Indian Pharmacopoeia Commission, Govt of India through vigiflow data base during 2022-23.
- 5) The entire functioning of the college has been switched to Enterprise Resource Planning software (**ERP**) under the Campus 7 platform from 21st April 2021, which helps the management and staff with smooth functioning and monitoring of academic and non-academic activities more precisely. In the academic Year 2022- 2023, we created user names and passwords to parents and training was also provided during the PTA meet.
- 6) We Constituted **IQAC** (Internal quality Assurance Cell) for quality Initiatives, Quality

Sustenance and quality enchantment. So far, 02 meetings have been conducted. IQAC will help us to prepare the Self-study report for NACC (National Assessment and Accreditation Council).

- 7) We Constituted the Institutional and Research Advisory Board (**IRAB**) with experts from recognized academic institutions, research centres and pharmaceutical industries, for improving the academic and research standards and to facilitate innovation and entrepreneurship concepts.
- 8) Introduced seed grant policy of Rs. 2 lakh for faculty to improve the research quality and to facilitate the funding process from government agencies. Three faculty projects were reviewed and one project was sanctioned by the members of Institutional and Research Advisory Board.

I.3. STUDENT ACHIEVEMENTS

- Students participated in various programs at pharmacy colleges and professional associations throughout the academic year 2022-2023.
- A total of **06** articles including review and research were published in reputed journals by students along with staff throughout the academic year 2022-2023, out of which **05** articles were published in Scopus /web of science indexed UGC care list Journals.
- **Around 10 papers were presented in various conference by students in the year 2022-2023.**
- **06 minor research projects were applied for financial assistance under KSCSTE (Kerala State Council for Science, Technology and Environment) in the year 2021-2022, and the recommended fund of Rs. 54770/- received from KSCSTE in the year 2022-2023.**
- **The Professional Society for Pharmacoeconomics and Outcomes Research (ISPOR) :** ISPOR Students chapter of Nirmala College of Pharmacy, helps to develop future leaders in the field of health economics and outcomes research, conducted various awareness programs like non-pharmacological management of non-communicable diseases/ polycystic ovarian diseases, etc., Community outreach programs at Nirmala Medical Centre, Caritas hospital and home medication counselling in the nearby locality, and conducted two webinars related to health economics by the group of Students and staff.
- With the joint effort of staff and students, the newsletter Volume “**Pharmaessence**” was published on September 2022.
- **Pharma alert:** it’s a good platform for students to learn new information in pharmacy and research. 13 batches have participated in the first cycle of Pharma Alert. Topics include

information regarding new drugs, new devices, and safety alerts.
