Candidates must have 80% attendance for both theory and practical training and must score at least 50% marks in examination to pass the course.

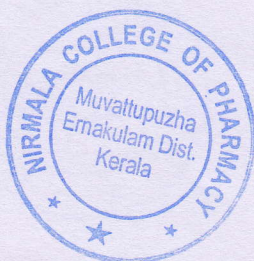
